Highlight of CTSN in-person business meeting at the 2022 AADOCR

For the first in-person AADOCR meeting since the pandemic, we were excited to see our CTSN members and friends from other scientific groups. During the business meeting, the following topics were discussed:

- Promote oral health importance to the political and insurance stakeholders to break the
 barriers of transforming research outcomes to clinical practice. For example, host symposiums
 to include politicians and insurance payers, demonstrate the importance of incorporating oral
 health care into medical practice, and reform the reimbursement system.
- Promote integration of oral health into medical health. Again, CTSN would serve as the best
 group to send the message; for example, having dental research representatives join the medical
 group conferences, and vice versa, invite colleagues from the medical field to join dental
 associations and conferences.
- Promote CTSN's financial stability and potentially seek sponsors for symposiums, providing more support to early-career researchers to attend conferences.
