For the last IADR meeting, the CTSN received 44 abstract submissions, and all abstracts (100%) were accepted. All abstracts were presented as oral and poster presentations. Our group also sponsored and co-sponsored 14 symposiums with high-level quality and scientific impact.








CTSN Keynote speaker and oral session
