Diversity Matters: Advancing Dental, Oral, and Craniofacial Research Leaders

On Saturday, March 15, AADOCR's Committee on Diversity and Inclusion (CDI) hosted a symposium session reflecting the need to emphasize diversity in the dental, oral, and craniofacial (DOC) research space.

The underrepresentation of minoritized scholars in the DOC research workforce presents a critical challenge to equitably serve communities across the nation. This

session took a step towards advancing equity and justice in the dental research enterprise by exploring strategies for leveraging community grounded, cross-disciplinary collaboration to support the advancement of historically minoritized scholars.

The session began with a panel of community leaders, professors, and scholars who shared their academic and professional journeys, highlighting how community and collaboration have facilitated their progress. Participants then engaged in small group discussions to identify strategies for collectively fostering the advancement of minoritized scholars in DOC research through community grounded, crossdisciplinary collaboration.



This session offered a unique opportunity for undergraduates, dental students, graduate scholars, researchers, and professors to form a network *across* institutions and build meaningful professional relationships. It also provided a framework for the CDI to sustain collaboration between attendees beyond the annual meeting.
